



The Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service (FMCS) is continuing efforts to keep the International Longshoremen's Association (ILA) and the United States Maritime Alliance, Ltd. (USMX) at the bargaining table with a meeting planed prior to the expiration of the contract extension on December 29<sup>th</sup>. With the possibility of a strike occurring as early as December 30<sup>th</sup>, the vessels listed below may be impacted. The most current schedule for these vessels can be found in the *Schedules* section of <a href="https://www.kline.com">www.kline.com</a> or by using our *Cargo Tracking* application by individual bill of lading or booking number; however, these schedules are subject to change based on the current status of the strike. "K" Line America, Inc. will continue to provide updated information as it becomes available. Any import cargo currently on dock should be drayed off the terminal as quickly as possible to prevent it from being held up by the potential strike. Any export loading appointments scheduled for after December 30<sup>th</sup> may need to be reevaluated based on the current status of the port operations.
